Budd schulberg (1914-2009) was the son of a hollywood producer, and is best known for his breakthrough novel what makes sammy run?, his screenplay for the film on the waterfront, and his boxing novel the harder they fall, made into a film starring humphrey bogart. The disenchanted, a play by budd schulberg and harvey breit.. [budd schulberg; harvey breit] -- loosely based on the life of american novelist f. scott fitzgerald, jason robards made a sensation on broadway in this exploration of the "lost generation," garnering multiple awards with robards
