Straight harp (1st position play): we traditionally think of campfire songs as the easiest to play with 1st position play. these songs such as “twinkle twinkle little star”, “mary had a little lamb”, “red river valley”, “home on the range”, “clementine” etc. are most often played in straight the chords are often used as Arrangements for melody instrument with lever harp accompaniment. guitar chords are included so that the melody may be played by any “c” instrument, accompanied by chords on harp, lute, guitar or keyboard. in addition, the melody could be played as a harp solo, adding the chords to the left hand.
