Abraham Lincoln, the Gettysburg address 19 November 1863 after a three-day battle against the Union Army at Gettysburg, Robert E. Lee's Confederate Army retreated on July 4th 1863. The battle was not only a major turning point in favor of the Union Army but was also the largest and most decisive battle of the American Civil War.

Lincoln built the Gettysburg address upon a structure of past, present, and future.
