Jane austen was wrong. in "mansfield park" she wrote that "nobody minds having what is too good for them," but the book's poor reception proves otherwise. it is the least popular of her Mansfield park, novel by jane austen, published in three volumes in 1814. in its tone and discussion of religion and religious duty, it is the most serious of austen's novels. the heroine, fanny price, is a self-effacing and unregarded cousin cared for by the bertram family in their country house. As is the most controversial element of the novel, the fact that the magnificent mansfield park was paid for with profits from the slave trade in the caribbean. there is a passing reference to this in austen's novel, but hamill makes it a major focus of her adaptation. Mansfield park is a 1999 british romantic comedy-drama film based on jane austen's novel of the same name, written and directed by patricia rozema. the film departs from the original novel in several respects. All in all, this is an extremely disappointing film if one cares about what was really written in mansfield park. i think "clueless" as a modern version of "emma" (and which i also enjoyed) is more true to austen than this let-down of a movie. Mansfield park was one of only two of jane austen's novels to be revised by her after its first publication, when a second edition came out in 1816 (this second edition was a failure in terms of sales).
